As an understanding grows and 'STOP' is practised, an automatic response can usually be developed to this command. Some children have difficulty comprehending that not all areas of their environment are safe, and an understanding of stop is critical for such children. Once the understanding of stop is developed, children are further challenged by the introduction of 'wait'. The development of this critical social skill is imperative for many situations within every day. This program very explicitly targets and teaches this necessary skill. This development, understanding and practise for your children will make not only their life better, but yours too!! This program has been developed in response to listening to the expression of so many frustrations of so many adults!
